

- Required In School Testing-
 - Spring 9th, 10th- PSAT
 - Fall 11th- PSAT/NMSQT in school
 - Spring 11th- SAT in school- Graduation requirement
- Optional-
 - SAT Subject tests, ACT
 - TOEFL, IELTS or Duolingo for English Language Learners



PSAT

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A score of 650 on the PSAT 8/9 would predict that a student would have scored a 650 on the PSAT 10 and the SAT had the student taken those exams at the same time.



National Merit Scholarship Program

Junior PSAT	Each year approximately 1.5 million juniors take the PSAT and enter the National Merit Scholarship Program. Only junior year PSAT scores are considered.	Oct 2020	
Commended Student	The top 50,000 students are recognized either as Commended Students (34,000) or as Semifinalists (16,000). For the Class of 2021, a Selection Index of 209 was required to achieve Commended Student status.	May 2021	
Semifinalist	inalist The 16,000 Semifinalists continue in the competition. Semifinalists are determined proportionally by state, and the score cutoffs vary by year. For updates, visit compassprep.com/national-merit.
