If you're still searching for colleges to apply to, utilize **Naviance**. In addition to being a search tool, this resource enables you to view recent college acceptance histories of Stevenson graduates.

If you are planning to take or retake the ACT or SAT, you may register by way of www.actstudent.org or www.collegereadiness.collegeboard.org/sat. See Stevenson's website for test dates.

For scholarship opportunities, go to individual college websites, Naviance, and www.fastweb.com.

Review college application requirements by going to a college's website. If teacher recommendations are required, contact recommenders now (personally) in order to provide them with ample time.
