NEW OPTIONS FOR CLASS of 2022

- > Unscheduled time may be requested for the 8th hour
- Athletic Waivers (see page 11 of Coursebook). Students who are on a JV/Varsity winter sport or have participated in a fall sport at the JV/Varsity level are eligible. Students must have six classes for credit (and participate in one sport) to qualify for a non-credit athletic waiver and five classes for credit (and participate in two sports) to qualify for a credit athletic waiver.
