KEY TAKEAWAYS

Theater teachers from the school's Fine Arts Division presented the latest on their journey to improve social emotional learning in the classroom. While recent data show that an overwhelming majority of students feel a sense of belonging in their theater classes, the faculty remain committed to improvement. Their focus has been on helping students with building self awareness and relationship skills — skills that are not only useful in high school and beyond but also mirror our Portrait of a Graduate. Teachers have introduced projects including oral storytelling, global theater research, multicultural/lingual scripts and personal story sound collage. Moving forward, the faculty will work to incorporate more diverse playwrights and texts in the theater curricula to better reflect student body diversity.



The Board of Education voted to approve the replacement of uninterrupted power source units, which are crucial to keep our network online in the event of a power outage, bump or surge. The units in need of replacement specifically power the school's main data center and other core networking devices. The cost to replace these units is estimated at \$138,265.
