## Review of East Building Bid Package 2

Discussions focused on the work that has commenced as well as the site preparation (construction fence, tree removal, additional electricity being provided, security and safety). This Bid Package contains the following skilled trades: plumbing, mechanical, electrical, drywall, painting, flooring, etc. Gilbane reviewed the scope with each vendor.

It was noted that Bid Package 1 for masonry, concrete, site work and structural steel has already been approved.

The remaining Bid package - Bid package #3 includes: photovoltaic panels, greenhouse, and door access/temp control systems.

This includes the replacement of the East Building and Pool roofs, moving Data Processing to room 7096, moving Little Patriots to the current Data Processing suites, work in the Orchestra room, Midi Lab, Percussion room, and Dance Studio, Transition House renovations, and the Port Clinton entrance rework. The Board will be asked to approve proceeding from Design Development Drawings phase to Construction Drawings phase.

## Fieldhouse Feasibility Study

Discussions focused on the considerable need for indoor/athletic/physical welfare space and the progress to date, which includes field trips to Homewood-Flossmoor,

Waubonsee Community College & Joliet Junior College. Administration also met with Wight & Co. to discuss a feasibility study. The next steps in the process include: further analyze the space needs and existing space usage as well as a larger feasibility analysis.

<u>Recommendations</u>: Accept Bid package #2 as presented. Approve Wight & Co. to move from design development phase to construction drawing phase for summer 2018.
