

Sick Student Policies

Condition	Exclusion Criteria	Return to School
Fever	If your student is found to have a fever of 100.4 F or more while on campus, or reports a fever 100.4 F or more within 24 hours, they will be required to be picked up from school immediately.	Must be fever free for 24 hours without the use of fever-reducing medication before returning to campus.
Vomiting	If your student vomits while on campus, or reports vomiting within 24 hours, they will be required to be picked up from school immediately.	Have not vomited for 24 hours.
Diarrhea	If your student has diarrhea on campus, or reports having diarrhea within 24 hours, they will be required to be picked up from school immediately.	Have not had diarrhea for 24 hours.
Rash	Based on nurse assessment and need for medical attention.	Based on nurse assessment and need for medical attention.
Cough	If severe enough to interfere with a student's ability to participate, or if accompanied by fever.	Fever free for 24 hours without the use of fever-reducing medication. Cough severity does not interfere with a student's ability to participate.
