The class of 2019 will receive a free SAT with Essay on April 10th, through Stevenson High School. Students can register for additional tests online (either ACT at www.act.org and/or the SAT at www.collegeboard.org/testing). Students should check with colleges to see if they require the writing/essay section respectively. Both websites offer free practice tests. Students can connect their College Board account, with a Khan Academy account for free, to receive customized test prep.
