PROGRAM NOTES

Hashivenu is a beautiful Israeli folk song with a plaintive melody seeking renewal. The voices begin in unison before developing into a 3 part canon, filling out the harmony. The delicate piano part adds to the flowing feel of the piece.

Gia il Sole dal Gange was originally a solo aria from Italian composer Alessandro Scarlatti's second opera which premiered in 1680. The song is a staple of the Italian art song tradition and has been performed by many classical singers. This arrangement adheres to the original piano and vocal lines while filling out the implied harmonies of the song structure.

The Snow was written by Edgar Elgar, a famous British composer of the Romantic Era in music. The text came from a poem by his wife, Alice Elgar, who was an accomplished author in her own right. In addition to his choral works, Elgar is famous for his orchestral compositions, including Pomp and Circumstance and Enigma Variations. The Snow is a challenging piece that includes beautiful parts for violin and piano. It depicts the simultaneous beauty and darkness of the winter.

Wanting Memories comes from the song suite "Crossings", commissioned by the Dance Alloy of Pittsburgh, PA. It's composer and lyricist, Dr. Ysaye Barnwell, is a member of the vocal ensemble "Sweet Honey in the Rock". The words are a beautiful perspective on overcoming loss and realizing one's ability to positively move forward in life.

Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart (1756-1791) is arguably the most famous composer of the Classical period and one of the most famous composers of all time. In his short life he composed over 600 works including operas, concertos, symphonies, keyboard works, and choral music. Mozart composed the *Requiem* in 1791, the last year of his life. Mozart died while composing the Requiem, and most musicologists consider the "*Lacrymosa*" to be the final piece of music that Mozart wrote. The remaining movements of the Requiem were finished by one of Mozart's students.
